


# WHY ARE WE CELEBRATING?

#### 5 BACK TO SCHOOL FACTS:



- The first public school was founded in Boston in 1635. It was a boys-only school until 1972, when it became co-ed. It's still functioning today.
- Most school days are marked by a ringing bell, a tradition thought to have been started in 1908 by a superintendent in Indiana.
- While most kids in America walk, bike, bus, or get driven to school, some students around the world take a boat, ride a gondola lift, or even zip line to class!
- The modern pencil was invented in 1795. And though we call them lead pencils, they're actually filled with graphite. A single pencil can draw a line 35 miles long!
- The first playground was built in England in 1859. Now it's known that recess is an important learning element of the school day too.

## 5 PEOPLE YOU SHOULD KNOW:

- Horace Mann: Known as the "father of American public education," Horace Mann was a politician in the 1800s who advocated for universal, secular, free education for all kids.
- Margaret Bancroft: A Philadelphia teacher in the late 1800s, Margaret Bancroft fought for the right of all students to receive a quality learning experience, becoming a pioneer in the field of special education.
- Anne Sullivan: As the woman who taught Helen Keller, a blind and deaf child, how to read and write, Anne Sullivan is one of the most famous teachers in the world.
- Ruby Bridges: At 6 years old, Ruby Bridges advanced civil rights history by becoming the first Black student to desegregate an all-white elementary school in New Orleans in 1970.
- John Holt: As a teacher frustrated with the public school system, John Holt supported the ideas of flexibility and unique learning styles for kids, helping to grow the homeschooling movement.
